Garden State Plan

In the Garden State Plan, providers outside of the State of New Jersey will not be covered; not for in-network or out-of-network claims. The only time an out of state provider/claim will be considered is if it is for an accidental emergency or medical emergency.

- An Accidental Emergency is <u>a traumatic</u> bodily injury which, if not immediately diagnosed and treated, could reasonably be expected to seriously jeopardize a person's health or result in loss of life.
- A Medical Emergency is <u>a sudden</u> condition and, at the time, unexpected onset of a health condition that requires immediate medical treatment and could reasonably be expected to seriously jeopardize a person's health or result in loss of life.

The prescription plan is the same as the NJEHP prescription plan. It includes Mandatory Generic, Step Therapy and a Formulary that excludes certain medications both Brand Name and Generic.
